HWRSD Assessment Letter- The School District did a great job holding down the budget this year.

Community Preservation Committee – The Board discussed estimates received for the cupola and masonry work at the Town House. The cost will be approximately \$20,000. John Flynn will attend the Community Preservation meeting on 3/21 to formally request the money under the funding allowed for historical restoration.

COA Transfer Request – The projected shortfall is approximately \$15,000. To date they have spent approximately \$11,000 on utilities.

Green Meadows Septic Agreement – Rick stated the liability seemed low on one bid and high on the other. Rick will talk to Dave Martel this week.

Centennial Commons Letter – Christina Evans talked to Dana Pixley for the lowest rate for the driveway pavement. The Selectmen will formulate a letter supporting the paving.

Town House Cleaning – A list was compiled of duties that would be considered for cleaning the Town House. The Selectmen will review.

NIMS Training – The Town will have all required people receive the training together. A trainer will come to the Town for training and testing.

Hazardous Mitigation Meeting – The meeting this week is on zoning. There are three more meetings by April 3, 2007.

Warrant – The warrant is in various places around town for viewing.
