The meeting was called to order by Duane Mosier at 6:00 pm.

Transfer Requests: The Board signed off on a transfer request for the COA for utilities and discussed other possible transfers needed. Town House utilities (\$3,000) and additional money for transfer station monitoring (23.2) (due to new State mandated testing, \$3,075.00) will be needed.

Outdoor Wood Furnaces: Anne McGregor, resident, came in to hear the decision of the Board relative to outdoor wood furnace burning and was told that all operations will cease by April 15th. The Board will send a notice to the papers alerting residents to the end of the season.

Howlett Hill Sign: The Board received a letter from Bob Majkut concerned about the placement of the "Road Maintenance Discontinued" sign. He is worried that it may affect potential buyers from showing interest in his property. He spoke with Rick Green and has agreed to split the cost of an additional sign stating, "Beyond This Point". He would also like a letter to Bob Majkut stating same.

Lions Club: The Lions are seeking a One Day Liquor and Food License for May 6 at The Hampden Nurseries for a car show so they could sell hot dogs, hamburgers, and refreshments.

This office will submit a bid request to the Central Register for a generator the Town House, contingent upon funding becoming available.

At 7:00 pm, the Board reconvened in the Auditorium for the Advisory Hearing.

At 9:00 pm, the Board reconvened in the Board of Selectmen's meeting room and a motion was made by Rick Green to adjourn the meeting, seconded by John Flynn.
