Minutes of November 16: The minutes were reviewed and a motion was made by Rick Green to approve as presented, seconded by John Flynn. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.

GASB 45 Report: The board will invite the Town Accountant and Town Treasurer in to discuss the findings of the report.

Primary Election: The board has to sign two warrants for posting; one is for the Primary Election for State Senator Kennedy's successor and the other is for the Special Election.

Tax Classification Hearing: The Board of Selectmen and Board of Assessor's have set the date of December 7th for the tax classification hearing. This will be posted in The Reminder.

Police Department: The Chief submitted his monthly report for review. The board will ask that he date the report in the future.

Resident Complaint: Karnig Zeroogian has contacted board members regarding his property on Wilbraham Road and the drainage issue he has. On more than one occasion the Highway Superintendent and Selectmen have looked at the site and determined that the drainage from the road does not drain onto his property and therefore the town has no responsibility in remedying the situation.

Police Department: Brett Purchas came before the board to discuss the disbursement of funds to the accounts for Great West versus Nationwide. A letter has been drafted and will be sent to the Treasurer to inquire about the status of these accounts.

With no further business, a motion was made by Rick Green to adjourn the meeting at 8:15 pm, seconded by John Flynn. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.
