The meeting was called to order by Vinnie Villamaino at 7:00 pm. John Flynn was attending a Regional School Budget Meeting.

Council On Aging Revised Budget: The Board reviewed the revised budget and has approved its submittal to Advisory. The board also received two letters of interest of members requesting a reappointment to the Council on Aging Board.

Inspector of Animal Nomination Vote: A motion was made by Rick Green to appoint Shelley Sears as the Town's Animal Inspector, second by Vinnie Villamaino. VOTE: All in favor and so approved.

Letter to TJ O'Connor Animal Control: The Board has written a letter to the members currently party to an agreement with the Animal Control Center, stating the Town's desire to terminate our contract due to cost constraints.

Minutes of March 2, 2010: The minutes were reviewed and a motion was made by Rick Green to approve as presented, second by Vinnie Villamaino. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.

Police Policy Review for: Rape Investigations, Testifying in Court and Strikes and Labor Disputes: A motion was made by Rick Green to approve policies as submitted, second by Vinnie Villamaino. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.

Framarin Proposal re: DEP Notice of Non-Compliance: The Board reviewed a proposal from our Water Operator for the public water supply and will gather more information before signing off on all costs.

Building Maintenance Issues: The board will send a letter to all departments notifying them that the town hall does not have a staff person to handle the many maintenance issues that come up. They will be informed of the whereabouts of particular items that as they see a need, they can respond to, light bulbs, etc.

Warrant Review and Selectmen's Annual Report: The board reviewed the status of both and will review again at next week's meeting.
