MEETING MINUTES

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30p.m.

Mountain Road: Warren Black came in to discuss the upcoming year's road projects and was wondering if Mountain Road was up for consideration. The Board will be meeting on Thursday to discuss the road projects for the coming year and projected schedules.

Advisory: The Selectmen went to the Melville Room to review and discuss the Budget for FY11. A suggestion of forming a Capital Planning Committee was discussed. The Advisory Committee was informed of future need of radios for both Fire and Police Departments mandated by the State. A discussion was started on non contractual workers receiving steps for wages.

Allen Court: A complaint came into the Selectmen's office regarding Allen Court and it was discussed.

Fire Department Letter: The Selectmen reviewed and discussed the recommendation from the Committee. Rick will meet with the Fire Chief and wrap up any loose ends. A motion was made by John Flynn to accept the results of the meetings and seconded by Rick Green. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.
