Stormwater Permitting: Tom Couture and Tracy Adamski from Tighe and Bond to help determine our next steps with the EPA relative to annual reports we are required to submit. When Dana returns from vacation we will check with him as to what mapping has already been done that would qualify for some of the requirements needed. We will also check with PVPC. Tom presented a map that showed the area we have to be concerned about. A stormwater program management checklist will be provided by Tracy Adamski to ensure proper reporting to EPA. She will also provide some dates as to when she can meet with us next to determine next steps. It appears we may have to start sampling all of the outfalls.

VFW Pavilion Permits: One day permits were requested for various reasons, as follows: one day liquor license for July 16, for a 50th birthday party, August 20 for a Jack and Jill event and September 17 for a 40th party all from 12:00 pm to 12:00 am. A motion was made by Vinnie Villamaino to grant a permit for a one day permit for the above referenced dates, seconded by Rick Green. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.

Hampden Nurseries: Hampden Nurseries has requested a one day liquor permit for a wine and cheese tasting event on Friday, June 24th from 5:00 to 7:00 pm. A motion was made by Vinnie Villamaino to grant a one day permit to the Hampden Nurseries for a one day permit for a wine and cheese tasting permit on June 24 from 5:00 to 7:00, with proceeds being donated to the Red Cross Tornado Relief Fund, seconded by Rick Green. Vote: All in favor and so voted.

Public Hearing for Liquor License Transfer: A notice was published in the paper for the transfer of a liquor license from the Blackhorse Tavern to McLadden's Irish Publick House. The hearing was scheduled for tonight, but there was miscommunication with the applicant and he thought it was for the 27th. Rick Green made a motion to open the hearing at 7:00 pm which was seconded by Vinnie Villamaino. There were no residents present for the start of the hearing. A motion was made by Vinnie Villamaino to continue the hearing until June 27th at 7:00 pm pending the approval of Town Counsel, seconded by Rick Green. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.

Planning Board: Members of the Planning Board, Charlie Dolben, John Matthews and James Quackenbush came before the board to discuss the recommendation of former clerk, Deb House as an alternate to the Planning Board. John Matthews stated that with Deb's experience as the clerk makes her an ideal candidate for the alternate position currently available. She comes strongly recommended by all members. A motion was made by Vinnie Villamaino to appoint Deb House as the alternate on the Planning Board, seconded by John Matthews. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.

Minutes of May 23, 2011: The minutes were reviewed and noted. Since there was no quorum, there is no vote on the minutes.

Minutes of May 31, 2011: The minutes were reviewed and a motion was made by Vinnie Villamaino to approve as presented, seconded by Rick Green. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.
