The meeting was called to order at 1:00 pm by Rick Green. Vinnie Villamaino was unable to attend.

Board of Health: A motion was made by John Flynn to approve the permit to operate a food establishment for Gio's Pizzeria at 9 Allen Street, seconded by Rick Green. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.

Board of Health: A motion was made by John Flynn to approve a Common Victualler's license for Gio's Pizzeria at 9 Allen Street, seconded by Rick Green. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.

Hampden Housing Authority: The board received a letter of resignation from Jackie Weissbach from the Housing Authority. The board will send a letter of appreciation to Jackie for her years of service to the town.

As a result a note will be sent to Charlie Bennett at Wilbraham-Hampden Times asking for a piece in the paper about the need for volunteers for the Hampden Housing Authority and the Conservation Commission.

The Selectmen received a list of proposed reappointments from the Fire Chief for the Fire Department. Rick would entertain an approval of the proposed list.

John Flynn moved to table the motion until the meeting on July 11th but before that asks that an email be sent to fire chief asking for list of current firefighters, and those who are not recommended for reappointment and the reason why. The note would include a reference to the letter the Chief had written relative to reappointments and ask to please call Rick to discuss.

Hampden Housing Authority: The board would like to meet with Housing Authority members on 7/25 to discuss the appointment of Patricia Clarke. We need to ensure they have a quorum present at the meeting.

Minutes: The minutes of July 27, 2011 were reviewed and a motion was made by John Flynn to approve the minutes with corrections, seconded by Rick Green. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.
