The meeting was called to order by John Flynn at 6:00 pm.

Minutes of March 16: The minutes of March 16, 2015 were reviewed and a motion was made by Vinnie Villamaino to approve as presented, seconded by Norm Charest. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.

Water Bill: The board approved payment of an invoice incurred for the final water connection for 613 Main Street.

Used Car License: The board reviewed a new license for the sale of used cars. A motion was made by Vinnie Villamaino to approve a used car license for Bilal Mhanna of BAF Auto Sales, at 482 Main Street, seconded by Norm Charest. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.

Hampden Housing Authority: John will contact Carol Collins so see if she might be interested in serving on the Housing Board.

Warrant Review and Ballot Questions: Reviewed.

Water Testing Bids: The board reviewed two bids to conduct annual water testing for the well located at the Highway garage to supply water to residents on Main Street. A motion was made by Vinnie Villamaino to award the bid to Test America, low bidder out of Westfield, MA, seconded by Norman Charest. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.

Mt. View License Update: The public hearing for the liquor license transfer for Mountain View will be held on April 6th at 6:30 pm. Matthew and Heather Bean will be purchasing the business.

Notice of Non-Compliance to Bagel Nook: The owners of the business have not been in compliance with the DEP and received notice of same. Lorri McCool will give them a week to come into compliance.

Advisory Hearing: Advisory has asked that a message be sent out via Connect CTY to notify residents of the upcoming Advisory Hearing on April 6th at 7:00 pm.
