Board Members: John D. Flynn, Norman Charest, Vincent J. Villamaino
The meeting was called to order by John Flynn at 6:00 pm.

Board of Health: Jane Budynkiewicz, Board of Health Coordinator came before the board to discuss the program that the DEA has held for years, involving a safe way for drugs to be disposed of to prevent soil and water contamination or drugs getting into unintended hands. Jane explained that the DEA is discontinuing their program, but one of the Police Officers was offered a kiosk to be installed at the Police Department. A motion was made by Vinnie Villamaino to allow the installation of the kiosk, with all proper precautions, seconded by Norman Charest.
VOTE: All in favor and so voted.

One Day Liquor License for Senior Center: Becky Moriarty requested two one day liquor license permits for events taking place at the Senior Center. They are as follows:

- Thursday April 16th for Volunteer Dinner from 5:00 – 9:00
- Sunday, April 12, Touch of Garlic Dinner from 5:00 – 10:00

A motion was made by Vinnie Villamaino to approve both permits as described, seconded by Norman Charest. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.

Monitoring at Transfer Station: The board reviewed a proposal from WjF, who has done water monitoring testing for the town at the transfer station. A motion was made by Vinnie Villamaino to approve the proposal for a total cost of \$10,233 for the April testing, seconded by Norman Charest. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.

BOH Fee Schedule: The board did a cursory review and would like to revisit the information at a later date.

Liquor License Transfer: The public hearing for the transfer of an existing liquor license for the Mountain View Restaurant was held in the Auditorium at 6:30 pm. Matthew and Heather Bean appeared as applicants along with their attorney. The board discussed the transfer, made a couple of clarifications and once satisfied, a motion was made by Norman Charest to approve the license transfer station, seconded by John Flynn. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.
Vinnie Villamaino, as an abutter, recused himself from the vote.

Advisory Hearing: The Advisory Hearing was held in the Auditorium at 7:00 pm. Doug Boyd, Carol Fitzgerald, Rick Rubin, Jeff Smith and Jamie Collins were in attendance and conducted the hearing. The warrant was reviewed as was the budget with questions from those attending.

At the end of the hearing, the board reconvened in their office. A motion was made by Vinnie Villamaino to adjourn the meeting at 7:50 pm, seconded by Norman Charest. VOTE: All in favor and so voted.
