7:00 p.m. - Meeting called to order

Minutes of February 9, 2004 meeting read – Motion to accept, with 2 amendments – change spelling meeting to meeting (7:25 – l. 1) and change surface to read finished grade ((7:30 – l. 29) made by Bonnie Geromini, second – Dick Gouvan. All in favor – minutes approved as amended.

Minutes of March 8, 2004 meeting read – Motion to accept with 3 amendments – Correct spelling of K. Desmarais, insert (overdue) following second (7:10 – l. 2), Change Sentence to read Letter of Acceptance contingent upon proof of Bond. (7:10 – l. 29) made by B. Geromini, second-D. Gouvan. All voted to accept as amended.

Minutes of March 15, 2004 Special meeting read. Motion to accept with following amendments: delete *that* we should (7:12, par. 2 – l.6), to read we should; Change spring to April (7:12 par.3, l.6), delete “the most” and one”, sentence to read This system, however, is not appropriate for this site. ((7:12, par.3, l.10) insert “Mr. Cafarelli commented”, sentence to read Civil Eng. for the project Ed Cafarelli noted best results could be achieved by direct discharge of clean road water into pond, where, Mr. Cafarelli commented, nothing is living anyway. ((7:12 – par.4, l. 5) made by B. Geromini, second, D. Gouvan. Minutes accepted as amended.

7:40pm – Makuch, 42 Evergreen Hearing

Heather Stavros of Pioneer Environmental present to represent Mr. and Mrs. Craig Makuch. Request for continuation of hearing until May 10. No word has been received from Heritage as yet. Commission requested that further information be provided regarding the clearing of wooded area. Pioneer to provide dimensions and square footage of area to be cleared, Submission referred to 7 trees, which covered only those with 5 inch or greater diameter. Motion made by S. Thompson to continue hearing to May 10 at 7:45. B. Geromini second – unanimous vote.

8:15 p.m. – Bedrock Financial, Lot #6, Scantic Road.

Principal failed to appear, issue has been held open for over a year, information not forthcoming. Motion made to terminate hearing proceedings on this site by B. Geromini, second D. Gouvan. Motion passed.

New business:

Bonnie Geromini to visit 107 Somers Rd. to inspect site for shed placement. Proof of bond submitted by Russell Morton reviewed; letter to be sent acknowledging acceptance.

D. Gouvan reported on site visit to lot#2 South Road – Gianetti site – Area of replication falls far short of conditions defined by CC, run-off pouring silt into area of replication. Letter to be sent to Mr. Gianetti requesting his appearance at May 10 meeting.

Scantic Meadows progress discussed and updated. Mr. Garner has not been granted access to property at this time and Board of Selectman has instructed Town Accountant not to pay bill submitted by Mr. Garner for services provided Conservation Commission.
