7:00 pm- Open meeting. Charlie Schmitt reported on the following:

Meeting held by Planning Board in regards to Hermanet property. They have met all of Planning Boards requests and received approval of plan.

Beavers have caused flooding of property on Mohawk Drive. Dana Pixley, Charlie Schmitt and owner walked property. The owner's drinking water has turned brown, septic system not working and flooding of property has occurred. An emergency order by the DPH was signed.

Tom Noel- Bayberry Road- Charlie Schmitt inspected property and did not find any standing water on property. He recommended that no further action needs to be taken as owners will notify Commission if any further work is planned.

Phil Grant reports that all work has been completed on roadbed at Cable property. Gary Weiner to notify us of how the water from spring at the top of property is going to be handled.

Phil Grant also reported that Persaud's property is being filled and that hay bales and stakes were not in place. Pete Levesque was notified and they went out and put these in place.

8:05 pm- Continuation of public hearing on Hermanet property, Thresher Road. Melanie Hermanet was in attendance and the Order of Conditions was reviewed.

Pat Cote made motion that the Commission accept revised plan 3.9.05 and the Order of Conditions as discussed and approved on May 4, 2005 meeting for Melanie Hermanet, Thresher Rd, Lot 102. Second by Charlie Schmitt.
