**HAMPDEN CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING
JUNE 26, 2010**

Present: Pat Cote, Bonnie Geromini, Phil Grant, Jeff Liquori and Judy McKinley Brewer

8:00AM-38 Carmody Road, Haskins- Site visit for the removal of wind damaged and fallen trees on property located at the end of caldesac on Riverpark Drive. Mr. Haskins will be hiring someone to come in and cut them up and take them away. There will not be any heavy equipment used.

8:15AM RFD- 43 Chapin Road- Hampden Septic, Inc.- Site visit and vote for the installation of a new septic system in exisiting driveway rather than crossing a seasonal stream. Commission voted to issue a Negative Determination for the septic system with the conditions that haybales and silt fence to be erected around the septic installation and to provide 72 hour notice before work is to begin so Commission member can inspect.

8:30AM RFD-South Road – Site visit and vote for the installation of a small footbridge for pedestrian crossing to be constructed across a stream. Phil Grant stated that according to the DEP in order to install the bridge without going to the army corps they will need to go from boulder to boulder and have the bridge anchored to them. Bonnie made motion to issue a Negative Determination for the construction of the foot bridge with the conditions that before construction begins a meeting will be held with a Conservation member and Norman Turnberg and also that the bridge will cross from boulder to boulder and then anchored to them. Seconded by Pat Cote. Motion approved.

Mindy Meeker, 8 South Road- Ms. Meeker wants to cut down a dead tree along the bank of the Scantic River. Site visit was completed and she will submit a RFD

A site visit was completed on property to check on wetland delineations. Heather Comee was present from Pioneer Environmental to provide the information and to identify the flagging.
