**HAMPDEN CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING
August 18, 2010**

Mark Stinson, DEP was present to do a site visit at 10 South Rd prior to the meeting. Pat described work already done like putting down mulch, trees already have been taken down, driveway put in. No digging of area only screen put down then cement. Proposed roof and deck plan were shown to be a pre-existing and not under Conservation Commission. Nothing will be done about the plastic and woodchips until he comes up with a restoration plan for planting along the 15" strip along the bank of the river. The restoration plan must be presented at the next meeting of Sept. 15, 2010 at 7P.M. The area along the driveway must be restored and grass planted. Tree cleanup will be allowed immediately with bobcat. End of driveway must be cleaned up and grass seed put down.
