**The Chairman called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. on Wednesday, November 17, 2010**

**7:00 P.M. Minutes from October 20, 2010 were accepted with a typing change.**

**7:15 P.M. The committee talked about the site visits that were done on November 6, 2010. The visits were done at Mr. Wilson, 50 Riverpark, Mr. Briand, 57 Riverpark, Mr. Weichselbaumer Riverpark & Carmody Rd and Mr. Efantis 10 South Rd which was a no-show. All visits were completed and noted with letters to the property owners. Mr. Efantis has been sent a letter and scheduled to come in for the December 15<sup>th</sup> meeting to discuss his re-vegetation plan.**

**7:25 P.M. A letter for site visits on December 11, 2010 were sent to property owners along the river. A follow up letter was sent to property owners on November 11, 2010 to reschedule the site visits . We will send out new notification dates at a later time.**

**7:30P.M. Richard Green, Selectman came in and talked about the grants he was trying to get for cleanup of the river. It seems that it would be too much work and not cost effective to try to apply for these grants. Mr. Green said he received a packet from Scott McCloud from FEMA and he would read through it and see if we would be able to use any of the info in it for removing the debris and large blocks of granite and cement from the river. He also talked about the agricultural land on Carmody Rd and just what it is being used for.**
