- 7:00 p.m.** Bonnie Geromini opened the May 21, 2014 meeting at 7:02 p.m.
- 7:05 p.m.** The April 16, 2014 meeting minutes were read. Judy McKinley Brewer made a motion to accept the April 16th minutes with changes. Ted Zebert 2nd the motion. All were in favor.
- 7:10 p.m.** The May 7, 2014 special meeting minutes were read and approved as amended with the changes. Phil Grant 2nd the motion. All were in favor.
- 7:15 p.m.** Tim Hanley, 19 South Rd came in to get his determination on his RDA to remove 4 dead trees on his property. Dana Pixley will be taking down three pines along with a maple tree. Bonnie Geromini and the Commission made a negative determination on this project. Determination will be typed and given to Mr. Hanley, DEP and one put in his file.
- 7:35 p.m.** Pastor MacLeod from the Bethlehem Baptist Church on Allen St needs to get an extension in July of 2014 for the development of the property. A discussion about the dirt too close to the water was made and he said he would talk to his builder about it. Pastor MacLeod stated that all the ground is cleared for the building and they will be breaking ground this week for the foundation.
- 7:40 p.m.** Mr. & Mrs. Bean, 240 East Longmeadow Rd closed on the property today. They were here to discuss the proposed building of a pole barn on their property. They were told to file an NOI and were given a blank copy to fill out and return to us.

7:55 p.m. Tim Hanley expressed interest in becoming a Conservation Commission member. Mr. Hanley was asked to submit a letter to the Selectman for him to be appointed to the Conservation Commission. All were in favor.

8:00 p.m. Phil Grant made the motion to close the April 16, 2014 meeting, Bonnie Geromini 2nd the motion. All were in favor.
