HAMPDEN PARKS AND RECREATION
MEETING MINUTES APRIL 25, 2006

Meeting called to order at 7:37pm.

Minutes: The minutes from April 11, 2006 were read. Huck made a motion to accept the minutes from April 11, 2006 as read. Tina seconded. All in favor 3-0.

Field Worker: A field worker is maintaining the baseball and softball fields. Huck will speak with John regarding this.

Letter from State: We received a letter from the State Board of Health regarding camp licensing exemptions. The Board decided that we are exempt. We are not a camp, just a summer activities program. We received another letter regarding sanitation with Laurie McCool's name on it. We will check with Laurie on this to see if she agrees with the Board.

Booklet received from Stan Tenerowicz of SweetBay Environmental about the Spray Park was reviewed.

Softball: Larry ordered new equipment. Some of last year's equipment was missing.

Dumpster: Huck has sent in a contract with Allied Waste for a dumpster at the Park. They will be picking up once a month. The dumpster will have a lock on it. It is scheduled to be delivered on April 26, 2006.

CPA Requests: The requested money has been granted for four bleachers at the Park and new fencing at the diamonds. Tina made a motion to use Brodeur-Campbell Fence Company to replace the fence at the Park. Larry seconded. All in favor 4-0. Seeding will wait until September. Huck will look into pricing and styles of the bleachers.

Financials: Tina and Deb will get together to go over the financials.
