Meeting Minutes November 9, 2010

Meeting called to order at 7pm

Minutes: The minutes from the October 24th special meeting and the October 26th regular meeting were reviewed. Marty made a motion to accept the minutes from both meetings as read. Mike seconded. The vote was unanimous 3-0.

Clerk Position – The Clerk’s position was posted and listed in the Wilbraham-Hampden Times in the Hampden Parks and Recreation column. Resumes and applications were received. Rick will schedule interviews for this weekend with Bob and Deb. The candidates will be narrowed down to one or two and have a second interview with the full Board at the next meeting on November 23rd. One application was received for the gym attendant position. Rick will schedule an interview. The possibility of hiring two people to share the position was mentioned.

Old Business:

New Wireless Scoreboard – funding for a new scoreboard was approved by RAH. A 9’ scoreboard and shock clocks will be purchased for TWB. Hampden Engineering will be doing the installation. A table top clock may be borrowed from Wilbraham as a backup until the new scoreboard is ready.

New Business:

Basketball – Mike ordered new reversible basketball jerseys, navy for the boys and Carolina Blue for the girls. Rick ordered game basketballs and the instructional basketballs. A CYO meeting will be on November 16th. There are 10 teams; home games will be on Saturdays from 9-6pm with away games on Fridays and Sundays. Suburban teams have been submitted to the League. Home games will be on Sundays. The Green Meadows gym will be open for practices on Sundays.

High School Intramural Rec Basketball – Hampden High School age kids can register in Hampden for the Wilbraham Rec Basketball League. The fee will be \$65. There will not be an additional charge for Hampden kids when they sign up in Hampden.

Bob made a motion that Hampden handles the High School registrations for boys and girls intramural rec basketball for Hampden students. Marty seconded. The vote was unanimous 4-0.

RAH – The current RAH president will be resigning as of January.

Bob made a motion to adjourn at 7:45pm. Mike seconded. The vote was unanimous 4-0.
