Eric asked if anyone had any issue with any of the presented coaches coaching and no objections were raised. Dave P feels that coaches should be able to choose their own assistant coaches. The CYO coaches practice schedules have been completed. There are 10-12 28.5 size basketballs at GM & TWB. Each team will receive a game ball. Admin to email players missing registration, liability waivers or payment and will cc coach and coordinator. Any new girls 3/4 registrations will go to Terry's team.

New Business: John Gurski attended the meeting to express his interest in the baseball coordinator position. Derrick explained that the hardest part is the timing – getting uniforms, parent requests, umpires, etc. Derrick will stay on as assistant coordinator. Eric added that we need a single point of contact. New equipment is needed for the program. Dave T will help inventory what is at RAH building.

Dave T motioned to appoint John Gurski as baseball coordinator and Derrick Biermann as assistant coordinator. Dave P seconded. All in favor 4-0
